As part of the study, qualified participants will receive free study-related skin exams and will be compensated for time and travel. Six visits over a 106-day period are required.

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Seborrheic keratosis is a common benign (not cancer) skin growth which often starts as small, rough bumps. Then they slowly thicken and get a warty surface. They range in color from white to black, and most are tan or brown.
